DISCUSSION ITEMS

- a. Kate SUAZO - Preferred Method of Guest Introductions
 - i. We have a lot of campus partners who would like to foster a complete relationship with ASFLC– what is the table’s preferred method of organizing communications?
 - ii. In the past, we’ve just added people to future agendas when their schedule worked with not a whole lot of input from the sitting table to choose who they want to hear from

ACTION ITEMS

- a. **Confirmation of Overland College as an RSO I - S.R. 25-04**
 - i. Club Representative – want to open up more educational & philosophical discussion around Christianity rather than be worship/sermon focused. Being an official RSO will make it easier for us to operate on campus. Build an open community on campus, and have already had events & interest. Funding is covered by Overland Church in town
 - ii. Passes Unanimously - Overland College Confirmed as an RSO I
- b. **Motion added by Speaker PAUL: A Motion to Censure**
 - i. Senate moves and passes to close the chamber to the public
 - ii. President WORTHINGTON leaves chamber; Vice President LEONETTI assumes position of chair
 - iii. Speaker PAUL moves to suspend the rules to suspend Robert’s Rules to open discussion on action item and provide clarification on a motion to censure; Seconded by CARLTON; Passes Unanimously
 - iv. Speaker PAUL reads pre-written explanation of purpose of censure:
 - 1. A formal recognition of a violation of rules by a sitting ASFLC member, not a punishment or consequence
 - v. *Motion to Censure 08-25* is passed out via physical copy to the entirety of ASFLC as Speaker PAUL reads it aloud
 - vi. The Senator in question is given to opportunity to speak and accepts
 - vii. Motion passes unanimously
 - viii. Speaker PAUL moves to re-open the chamber to the public; Seconded by CARLTON; Passes unanimously; Chamber is opened
